Communications Expenditure

Thank you for your letter dated 14 December 2009 addressed to [REDACTED], who has asked me to respond on his behalf.

With effect from the 1 January 2010, you can not use the Communications Expenditure or utilise resources acquired from the Communications Expenditure for the production of newsletters, Parliamentary reports, targeted letters, petitions, surveys, surgery leaflets and flyers (in other words a ban on anything that could be put through the letterbox).

In this context, the items you submitted for consideration can not be used after 31 December 2009.

However, it is possible for you to refund the cost of the surplus items you have in stock to the Communications Expenditure. You will then be at liberty to distribute round the constituency after 1 January as you see fit. If you wish to pursue this course of action, please submit a cheque made payable to 'House of Commons - Members' together with a copy of this letter.
